On August 5, 1862, Rear Admiral David Farragut led the Union fleet to the Battle of Mobile Bay, as signal officer. Confederate forces, guarding Mobile Bay, the only part of the Gulf Coast still under Southern control. Farragut's fighting line sank four ironclads and drove off the rest of the force. Of those sunk, the Florida and the Morgan. Within the month, both these key bases had surrendered. Farragut had scored one of the important naval victories of the Civil War.
