**KIT DESCRIPTION  
AND  
BUILDING NOTES**

This model is a resin, white metal and brass photoetch kit. The model depicts the USS Oakland as she appeared in December of 1944. Testors model master enamel paints were mixed to achieve the navy blue and deck blue colors. The Oakland was the lead class for the Atlanta-Oakland class of light cruisers for the US Navy. These cruisers were designed as anti-aircraft cruisers but they were often employed in various rolls including direct actions against the Japanese surface fleet in the early days of the Pacific war.
